Customer Review:

Having owned a large boat for fishing the Firth and a small boat for Raglan harbour, I decided to settle on a mid-sized boat that could be towed by my RAV4. I settled on a Fin Chaser 430 powered by a 40hp Mercury 4 Stroke motor, with trim and tilt, on an aluminium trailer. It is a lovely boat with plenty of deck area and space to swing a fishing rod without clashing rods with other crew.

I have found the boat is very stable, has adequate power and performs very well in rough water. It is also a very dry riding boat. The sealed airtight subfloor and buoyancy fitted at the gunnels provides reassurance. I chose the side steer model (SS) providing a side console with steering wheel and remotes operating like a 'normal' boat. Extras I fitted included a Viper drum winch, and a bimini top for sun protection. Max, Gary and the crew have been a pleasure to deal with and have provided me with excellent help and advice. Very happy with my purchase.
